The “Financial Protection” Educational Programme (EP) is based on the “Financial Security” EP, the initial version of which, taking into account the expansion of the name of specialty 072 (the addition of “Stock Exchange”) in accordance with Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 1392 dated 16.12.2022 – was approved at the meeting of the Department of Accounting and Auditing, Minutes No. 10 dated 19.05.2023; the EP was assigned a code in EDEBO (the Unified State Electronic Database on Education). Subsequently, updated content and amendments to the EP were approved at meetings of the Department of Accounting and Auditing – Minutes No. 8 dated 25.03.2024, Minutes No. 11 dated 25.06.2024, and Minutes No. 9 dated 23.04.2025.

In connection with bringing the name of the EP into compliance with the requirements of Article 9¹ of the Law of Ukraine “On Higher Education” (as amended by Law No. 3642-IX dated 23.04.2024) and the changes to the classification of specialties introduced by Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 1021 dated 30.08.2024, the name of

the EP was refined to “Financial Protection”. The new name was agreed by letter of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 3/4575-25 dated 29.05.2025.

The updated version of the “Financial Protection” EP was approved at the meeting of the Department of Accounting and Auditing, Minutes No. 10 dated 29.05.2025. The programme was registered in EDEBO as a new educational programme; the first intake of students under this programme is the 2025/2026 academic year.

The Educational Programme was updated in accordance with the Higher Education Standard of Ukraine for the first (bachelor's) level of higher education, field of knowledge 07 “Management and Administration”, specialty 072 “Finance, Banking and Insurance”, approved by Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 729 dated 24.05.2019 (as amended by Orders of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 593 dated 28.05.2021 and No. 842 dated 13.06.2024); Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine “On approval of the subject test programme in accounting and finance for the unified professional entrance examination” No. 154 dated 11.02.2022; Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine “On amendments to the list of fields of knowledge and specialties for the training of higher education students” No. 1392 dated 16.12.2022; the Law of Ukraine “On Higher Education” (as amended by Law No. 3642-IX dated 23.04.2024); Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine “On amendments to the list of fields of knowledge and specialties for the training of higher education and professional pre-higher education students” No. 1021 dated 30.08.2024; Article 6² of the Law of Ukraine “On the Fundamentals of National Resistance” and the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated 30.06.2026 No. 1002 were also taken into account.

Purpose of the educational programme	Training of specialists in the field of finance, banking, insurance and the stock market, who possess up-to-date theoretical knowledge and practical skills, the capacity for independent learning and self-development, and the ability to solve applied problems in the field of financial protection, identify financial risks, assess threats, and develop and implement effective solutions to ensure the financial stability of business entities and public sector institutions under conditions of decentralization, digitalization, and European integration transformations. Learning objectives — training specialists capable of solving complex specialized tasks and applied problems characterized by complexity and a certain degree of uncertainty of conditions, both

	in professional activity in the field of finance, banking, insurance and the stock market, and in the course of study.
3- Characteristics of the Educational Programme

Programme orientation	The EP is oriented towards students acquiring professional knowledge, skills, abilities, and other competencies, including language, for successful professional activity. It is based on well-established propositions and the results of contemporary research in finance, banking, insurance and stock exchange. It envisages the acquisition of practical skills and mastery of contemporary approaches to ensuring the financial protection of economic entities, and is oriented towards relevant educational programmes within which further professional careers and/or study are possible.
Main focus of the educational programme and specialisations	The emphasis is placed on the integrated formation and development of professional competencies in the field of financial protection of subjects of financial relations, in particular the state, business, and households, as well as skills necessary for the analysis, modeling, and forecasting of financial processes, and the assessment of financial risks and threats for making effective professional decisions and ensuring their implementation. The programme provides opportunities for employment, further education, and career growth at the master's level, with a professional or academic orientation. <i>Keywords: finance, money and credit, corporate finance, budget system, tax system, banking system, stock market, insurance, financial sector and capital markets, financial security of business entities, financial security of the state.</i>

Distinctive features of the programme	The educational programme is built on the results of advanced research in the field of ensuring the financial security of corporate and public finance; provides in-depth study of the disciplines constituting its subject area; is aimed at training specialists capable of comprehensively solving applied problems related to ensuring the financial protection of subjects of financial relations. A distinctive feature of the educational programme is the delivery of certain components in a bilingual format. The programme also provides an opportunity to gain in-depth knowledge with an emphasis on forming a theoretical basis and practical skills for diagnosing threats and dangers to financial systems, based on the use of innovative simulation modeling technologies in a virtual environment and e-learning, as well as the involvement of practicing professionals in the educational process. The EP provides for the possibility of international exchange and academic mobility within Ukraine and abroad. <i>The competitive advantages of the programme</i> lie in providing students with the professional competencies necessary for research and practical work, which are in demand in any field of activity (business, public sector institutions, civil service, non-profit organizations, etc.) where it is necessary to apply analytical competencies and make complex professional decisions under uncertain conditions of the functioning of the financial system.

5 – Teaching and Assessment	
Teaching and learning	The teaching process applies modern learning approaches: student-centered learning, self-directed learning, and problem-based learning, using blended (active, interactive, and distance) forms of instruction combined with extracurricular (independent) work with the possibility of consultations with the instructor, and internship. The educational process is built on an individual-creative approach and is based on the research results of leading scholars, the study of official state statistical information, statistical information from the financial departments of local self-government bodies, public organizations, and the financial statements of business entities. The teaching process includes both traditional and innovative methods and technologies: lectures, practical and laboratory classes, seminars, and trainings based on interactive methods, forms, and techniques (virtual business games, brainstorming, the interview method, work in small groups, presentations of own research). It is standard practice to involve qualified practicing professionals in conducting classes.
Assessment	A cumulative point-rating system, which provides for the assessment of students in all types of classroom and extracurricular educational activities aimed at mastering the academic workload of the educational programme: ongoing and final assessment. Assessment of students' academic achievements is carried out using: a 4-point national scale (excellent, good, satisfactory, unsatisfactory); a 2-level national scale (pass/fail); a 100-point scale; and the ECTS scale. Assessment within ongoing monitoring is carried out during classroom (seminar, practical) classes, independent mastery of educational components, and modular tests. Final assessment — examinations, credits, and differentiated credits taking into account accumulated points from ongoing modular monitoring; defence of internship and term papers, as well as qualification/diploma theses. Attestation — passing a comprehensive attestation examination in the field of study, a comprehensive foreign language examination, and defense of the qualification thesis..

8 - Resources for Programme Implementation

Academic staff	The core teaching staff of the educational programme consists of academic and teaching staff from the departments of Ferenc Rakoczi II Transcarpathian Hungarian University. The lecturers teaching within the programme are active and recognised scholars who publish their work in domestic and international scientific literature, and who possess the relevant professional competence and experience in teaching, research, and pedagogical activity. Academic and teaching staff undergo professional development once every five years. The practice-oriented nature of the educational programme envisages the broad involvement of practitioners whose expertise aligns with the programme's focus, as well as the engagement of highly competent experts — including representatives of professional unions and associations and foreign specialists — in teaching, thereby strengthening the synergistic link between theoretical and practical training.

	Teaching of compulsory components in Hungarian or English is ensured by instructors with a language proficiency level of at least B2, as confirmed by an appropriate document. The Guarantor of the educational programme and the academic and teaching staff ensuring its implementation meet the requirements set out in the Licensing Conditions for the Conduct of Educational Activity of Educational Institutions.
Material and technical support	The available premises meet the standard area requirements. The educational process under the programme is fully provided with lecture halls and laboratories. Classrooms are equipped with multimedia equipment. Specialised computer classrooms with the necessary software and unlimited open access to the Internet are available for practical and laboratory work and for information search and processing of results. Infrastructure for leisure and health improvement is available (2 canteens, a sports ground, a sports hall, a gym, a medical office, etc.).
Information and educational-methodological support	The Institution's official website contains information on educational programmes, educational, scientific and extracurricular activities, structural units, admission regulations, contacts, etc. The information and educational-methodological support of the "Financial Security" educational programme for training specialists in speciality 072 "Finance, Banking, Insurance and Stock Exchange" meets licensing requirements, has up-to-date content, is based on modern information and communication technologies, and is posted on the official website of Institution. The language of instruction is specified in the syllabi of the relevant compulsory components. Higher education applicants have access to: unrestricted internet access (Wi-Fi covers the entire territory of the HEI); a scientific library, repository, and reading rooms; academic process schedules; and educational-methodological support for the educational components. The HEI uses the "IRIS" educational process management system.

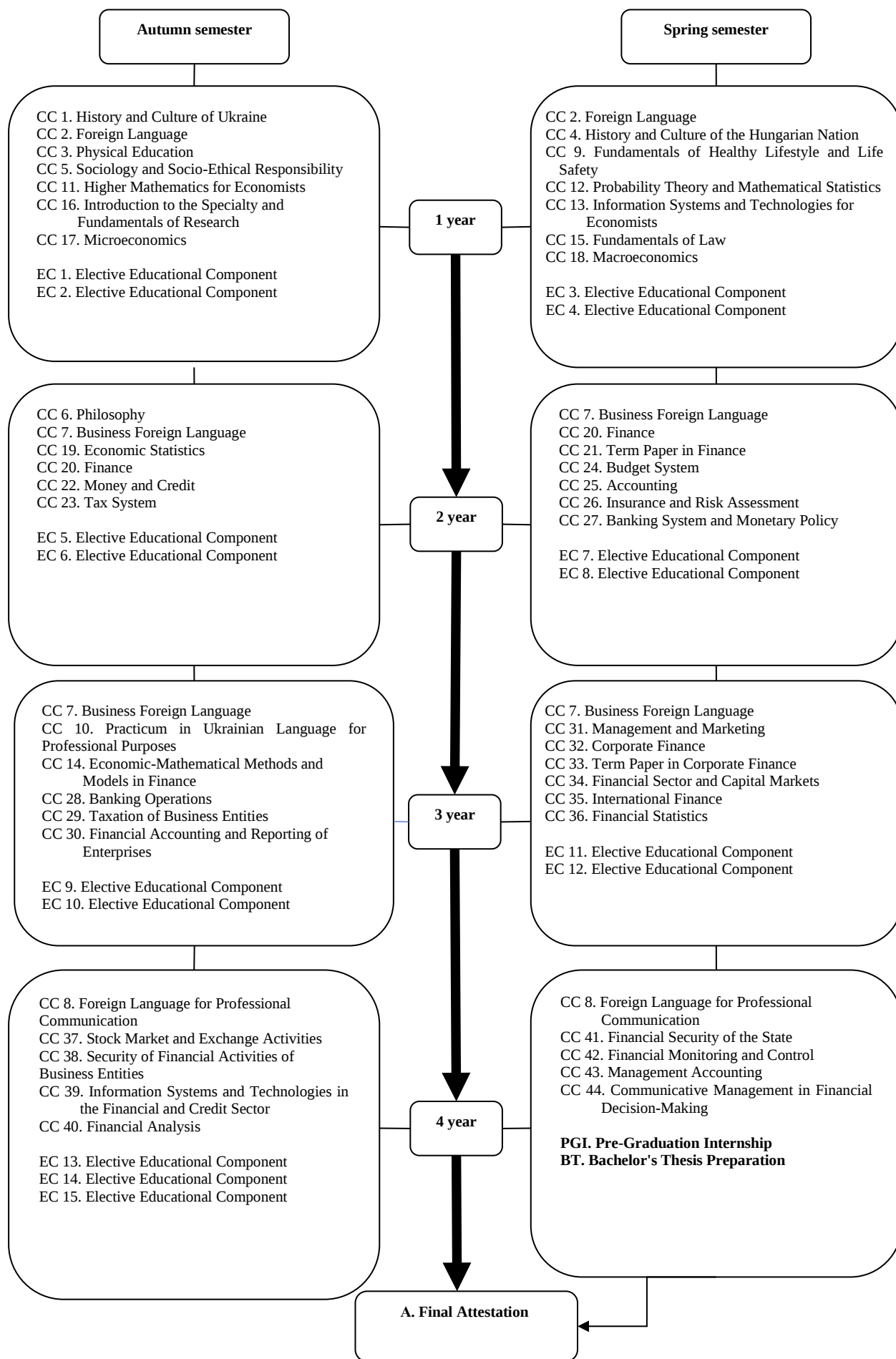

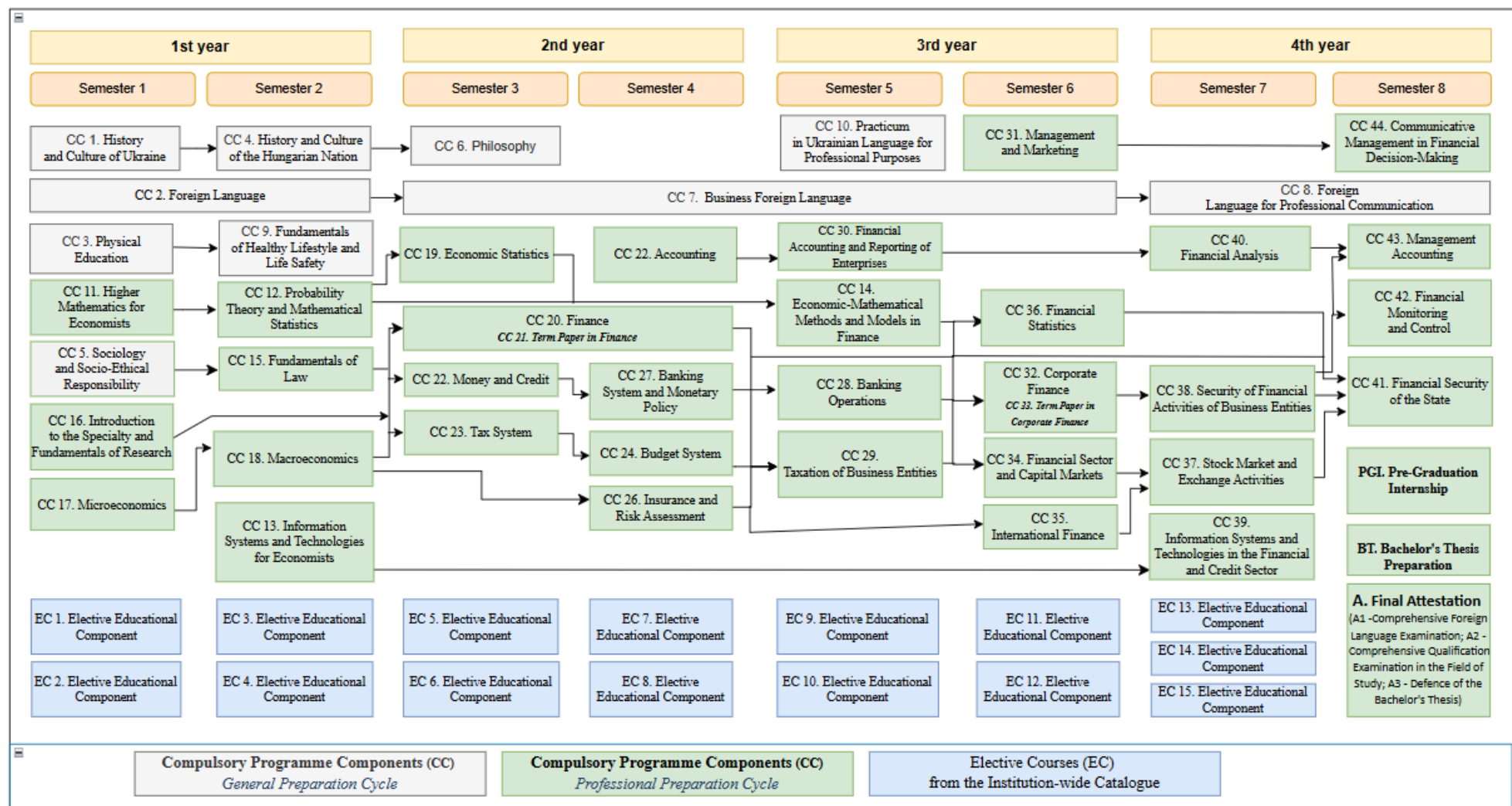
